ON THURSDAY:



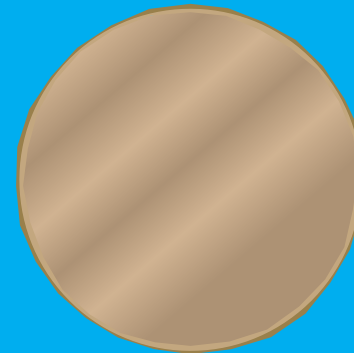
KAY BROUGHT IN LOTS MORE LOGS.

TOMATO CAGE WOULD WORK.

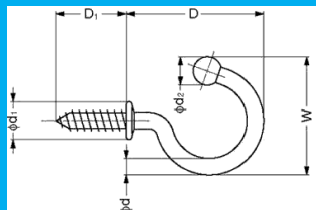
ON FRIDAY:

THE FAN.

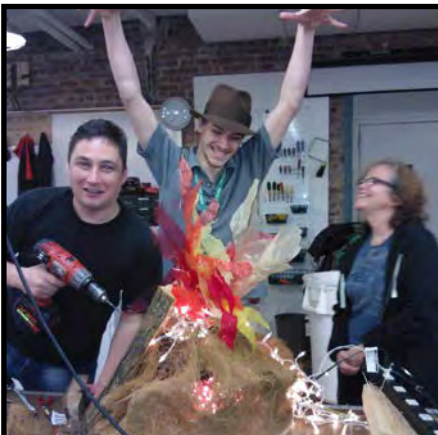


KAY TRIMMED
THE LOGS.

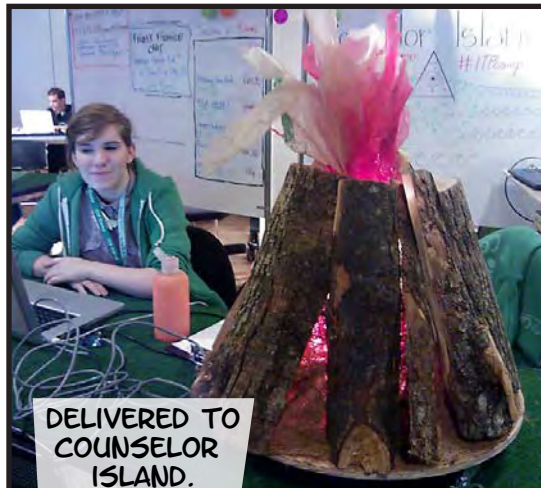


WE TESTED THE
